What major actions or projects have been completed by your group since July 1, 2010?

- 1) **Motion: 2010:03-** The Board moves to award up to 3 - \$5,000 grants for the 2012 fiscal year and not to exceed \$15,000 total.
- 2) Cultivating New Voices of Scholars of Color (CNV) will have a small reception inviting past and present CNV scholars as well as early career teachers of color in NCTE at the NCTE Annual Convention following the all day CNV gathering on Thursday, November 17, 2011.
- 3) **Motion: 2010:04-** The board approves the funding of up to \$2,000 in support for a reception in honor of the past and present CNV scholars as well as early career teachers of color in NCTE at the 2011 NCTE Annual Convention in Chicago, Illinois.
- 4) The 2012 CNV Spring Institute will be held on the campus of The University of Texas at Austin in Austin, TX with the date to be determined (they generally meet the first part of March).

What projects, initiatives, or studies are “in progress” at this time?

Susi Long sent out a survey to all the current and former CNV fellows to get their feedback on how the CNV Program has impacted them personally, and professionally. She asked what specific publications and other professional opportunities were inspired/influenced/supported because of their work in CNV and what their contributions to and involvement in NCTE are the results of CNV.
