UPDATED SESSION TITLES OR ANNOTATIONS**A.52**

Revised annotation:

This session reports on four studies of preservice teacher learning: (1) two English educators will describe how they embedded narrative-based pedagogical approaches into their teaching of an online content area literacy course; (2) teacher educators and preservice teachers from two universities will present data examining processes and outcomes of two anti-racism student organizations developed to prepare preservice teachers to address issues of racism in early childhood and elementary education; (3) presenters will share research on a co-teaching model that helped preservice teachers implement reading, writing, and discussion protocols with high school students in a summer Upward Bound program; (4) presenters will discuss helping preservice urban teachers learn and apply skills in four competencies: (i) sociocultural knowledge, (ii) affirming attitude, (iii) collaborative skills, and (iv) pedagogy for diversity.
