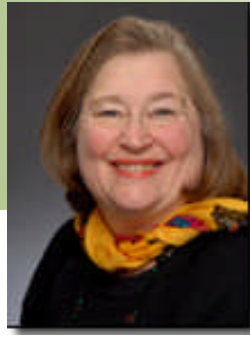


# Amy Benjamin
